First, let me thank all the local hosta clubs that ordered our "Club" hostas last year. Every year we try to find a group of new hostas that we offer to hosta clubs at a special wholesale price. Please order early as some hostas may be limited. We can send them bare root or maybe in the pots, just ask about the best shipping times.

Again, this year we have two new hostas for clubs that will not appear on other wholesale lists. 'Briar Patch', a prickly little blue-green hosta, and 'Bubble Wrap', a highly pebbled variegated hosta. Two of our newest hostas are also on the list, 'Bluebigwa' and 'What's Mine Is Yours'. **Clubs can also order off our wholesale lists, both liners and bare root plants if quantities allow.**

The hostas listed below are sold as bare root divisions in multiples of five. They have been grown out to fill a one quart or larger pot, except for minis. 'Baby Blue Eyes'

GHF introduction

Small. Little blue hostas are rare, especially those that are vigorous. This cute little blue baby has perfectly formed dark blue heart-shaped leaves that make a dense flat mound. **\$8.00**

'Bluebigwa'

New, First-time introduction

Large. This is another stunning large blue hosta from Charlie Kwick. It has the classic heart-shaped leaf shape, puckering, and clump habit we all admire with a unique rich blue color that saturates the very large leaves. It grows well, too. **\$15.00**

'Briar Patch'

New, First-time introduction

Small. This fast-growing small hosta from Randy Goodwin makes a ground covering thicket of very interesting blue-green foliage. The tangle of leaves gently undulates to a very sharp point that may appear prickly. A great Hosta Show plant that is definitely different. **\$18.00**

'Bubble Wrap'

New, First-time introduction

Medium. Here's a fun hosta from Doug Beilstein. Just look at all those puckers on a highly cupped variegated leaf. Doesn't it just make you want to try to "pop" them and soothe the soul a little. It's okay, hostas love to be touched, and this one is tough enough to take it. **\$18.00**

'Charlie Jane'

Large, the very large deep blue perfectly round leaves have incredible substance and are filled with deep puckers. It makes a bold statement. A classic introduction from Charles Kwick. **\$8.00**

'Chiller'

Medium. Doug Beilstein describes his new hosta as having a "unique "chill" color of powder blue on broadly ovate leaves with small ruffles and serrations around the rim". Another product of 'Neptune', here crossed with 'Astral Bliss' to add to your collection. **\$10.00**

Large. This is an very elegant hosta. The cupped almost perfect heart-shaped leaves open wide, shining in the sunlight. The wide veins and flat habit add to the attractiveness of each leaf. It is a new eye-catching hosta from Charlie Kwick. It is one of my favorites. **\$10.00**

Mini. So many hosta folks are enamored by all white hostas only to be disappointed when they do not grow well for them. There is always a race for them to turn green before they melt. This little sport of 'Hideout' is a winner! Emerging pure white it becomes a very attractive green hosta in late spring. **\$10.00**

'Granny's Goosebumps'

Medium-Large. Amazingly, the "goosebumps" while distinctive are not the most enticing part of this hosta from Don Rawson. The leaves emerge light yellow and become green in summer, it is a "spring gold" but it is the form of the clump that is so appealing to the eye. Those large irregular leaves are held out wide creating a spreading clump of low foliage making it the perfect specimen for the corner of the hosta bed. **\$15.00**

'Lord Puckersheen'

Large. I was asked recently if genetically a hosta can be both puckered and shiny. I immediately replied, "Yes, 'Lord Puckersheen'". I got a few strange looks but went on to describe Charlie Kwick's new hosta. It is large, with dark green leaves that are yes, puckered and shiny and also a little unruly. It should make a good parent for those traits and make a great conversation starter. **\$15.00**

'Stranded on a Sandbar'

Small. Variegated sport of 'Lettuce Wrap'. Some hostas are just blessings from the lab. This variegated form of our small yellow hosta 'Lettuce Wrap' sports yellow margins that become creamy in summer. Like many light-margined yellow hostas the leaf center appears to be greener than its parent. It magically is also nice and vigorous here in the nursery. Part of our "Sports Bar" series, it is my small tribute to the passing of Jimmy Buffett. **Special \$18.00**

'What's Mine Is Yours'

New, First-time introduction

Medium. This is a special hosta for many of us. It is from our late good friend Jack Barta. He shared it with just a few friends labeled simply as "Mine". As it turns out it has leaves that are beautifully cupped but also margins that have gentle waves, a rare combination. It is also one of the darkest blue hostas, looking almost purple in the shade sometimes. Now 'What's Mine Is Yours' **Special \$12.00**
