'Alligator Rock' NEW Medium to Large. Dark green leaves that show a little blue in spring are beautifully puckered in regimented rows. It makes a compact mound that looks attractive into late summer and fall. **\$15**

***'Ambrosia'** Large. Waxy, blue leaves with a light-yellow center, 'Guacamole' sport with very fragrant flowers. **\$10**

'Aphrodite' Large. Double flowered form of H. plantaginea. \$8

'Bud Lite' Limited! Medium. This special gift from Floyd Rogers is a product of Doug Beilstein's red petiole hybridizing. It does have nice petioles, but it is the outstanding flowers that make this hosta special, that and the name, too. **\$12**

'Big Bubba' Very Large. Upright blue green, somewhat unruly leaves that are loosely cupped, folded, and ruffled. Throw in a few puckers and you have a great big good old boy hosta. **\$10**

*'Bluebird of Happiness' Medium. This tetraploid seedling features thick leaves with super substance that fold and wave, perhaps reminding you of a bird of paradise. **\$10**

'Brocade' Limited! Medium. This bright and shiny hosta has leaves that are highly ruffled with the petiole pinched at the base of the leaf blade beautifully reflecting sunlight. **\$12 'Bubble Wrap' NEW** Medium. Here's a fun hosta from Doug Beilstein. Just look at all those puckers on a highly cupped variegated leaf. Doesn't it just make you want to try to "pop" them and soothe the soul a little. It's okay, hostas love to be touched, and this one is tough enough to take it. **\$18**

*'Buttonwood Bay' Medium. Our very blue hosta reminds me of moving waves, continuously rolling west toward the tropical sunset. Its very blue pointed leaves are tightly ruffled making a neat, symmetric mound. **\$10**

*'Chicago Blues' Limited! Medium. This third-generation selection from my "Longiana" line has the most purple petioles of all of its siblings. In May the deep, rich blue foliage takes on a purple cast under its heavy white wax. It is an extremely sturdy hosta, outstanding in a container. **\$12**

***'Clear Blue Sky'** Medium. Attractive blue hosta that is upright and holds its blue color well. This cross of 'Summer Squall' and 'Fragrant Blue' looks as good in late August as it does in May. **\$12**

'Dandy Lion' Limited! Medium-Large. A sturdy yellow hosta with ruffles and some puckering on its leaves, does not burn in the spring for us here in North Carolina. **\$12**

'Deep Blue Sea' Limited! Medium. A medium-sized blue hosta from Charles Seaver, the almost perfectly round leaves are well known for their cupping and puckering. The flowers are medium lavender. The deep blue coloring makes for a garden classic. **\$8**

***'Doubled Up' Limited!** Large. This sport of *H. plantaginea* found at our nursery has flowers that are larger than species that open wide, with shorter, thicker scapes and the clump is more compact, the leaves having great substance. **\$10**

'Dragon's Dream' Medium. Waxy blue gray leaves that are intensely ruffled have nice white backs. It makes a loose mound of delicate looking foliage. **\$10**

'Epic Blue Wave' Medium to Large. Wavy blue pointed leaves that are slightly folded and nicely corrugated make a very attractive mounding clump. A good solid nursery plant, it's better than I had guessed. **\$12**

'Evening Blush' Medium. Very blue undulating leaves with a striking red scape from Don Dean. **\$10**

*'First Blush'^{PP28920} Medium. Green leaves with red petioles and red margins, then entire leaf blushes purplish red. Our first red-leafed hosta is a true breakthrough!

'Flash Freeze' Large. The powder blue leaves of this new introduction from Doug Beilstein are cupped and somewhat puckered and tend to overlap and wrap around their petioles. **\$12**

*'Frost Giant' Very Large. An upright stately clump of large pointed blue leaves with bright yellow margins. **\$10**

'Gold Elation' Very Large. This yellow seedling from 'Elatior' grows into a tall spreading clump that resists spring burn here in North Carolina. **\$15**

'Granny's Goosebumps' NEW Medium-Large. Amazingly, the "goosebumps" while distinctive are not the most enticing part of this hosta from Don Rawson. The leaves emerge light yellow and become green in summer, it is a "spring gold" but it is the form of the clump that is so appealing to the eye. Those large irregular leaves are held out wide creating a spreading clump of low foliage making it the perfect specimen for the corner of the hosta bed. **\$15**

'I Dream of Jeanne' Large. Classic bright golden heart-shaped leaves with light waves and impressive blooms of flowers. **\$8**

'Jane's Blush' Medium. Nice dark blue hosta that may blush some purple on the tops of its leaves in cool spring weather, more reliably in the North. **\$10**

'Jasmine' Large. Probably tetraploid, the very shiny thick green leaves with prominent veins are topped in late summer with very fragrant flowers that smell like Jasmine. **\$12 'Jaws'** Medium. Spear shaped tightly ruffled, almost toothed green leaves make an imposing clump that grows quickly. **\$10**

'Kim' Large. This hosta has very round waxy light blue leaves that create a very round upright clump. **\$10**

'Lord Puckersheen' NEW Large. I was asked recently if genetically a hosta can be both puckered and shiny. I immediately replied, "Yes, 'Lord Puckersheen'". I got a few strange looks but went on to describe Charlie Kwick's new hosta. It is large, with dark green leaves that are yes, puckered and shiny and also a little unruly. It should make a good parent for those traits and make a great conversation starter. **\$15**

'Megan's Angel' Very Large. A vigorous sport of 'Blue Angel' with bright yellow margins. **\$8**

'Miss Mykah' Medium. This dark green centered sport of 'Golden Friendship' has excellent substance and great color. **\$10**

*'Orange Marmalade'^{PP16742} Medium. Classic blue leaves with a yellow center that turns orange in May. **\$10**

*'**Peace and Quiet'** Medium. Sport of 'Pandemonium' with creamy white margins. The scapes are dark purple and filled with light purple flowers. **\$10**

*'Rough Lemon' Limited! Medium. Unique leaf shape with brilliant red petioles. Gorgeous yellow spring color and fast-growing habit. **\$15**

'Rowan my Boat' Limited! Medium. Puckered waxy blue leaves that are folded into petite kayaks. **\$8**

'Smash Hit' Limited! This sport of 'Orange Marmalade' has a wide dark blue margin and a similar yellow leaf center that will become orange in May. **\$12**

'Speakeasy' Limited! Large. This sport of 'Powder Blue' has very blue waxy rounded leaves with a rich yellow margin that becomes cream in the summer. **\$15**

*'Sugar Cookie' Medium. This tasty holiday delight is a sport of 'Sugar Plum' found here at Green Hill Farm. It has the same rich purple petioles and white leaf backs of its parent with an added light-yellow margin that brightens to pure white in summer. Perfect in a container or as a special accent in the garden. **\$15**

*'Sun Worshiper' Medium. Fast growing hosta that holds its yellow color very well through the season. **\$8**

'Talking Point' Medium. Long pointed blue leaves create an arching mound. A conversation piece. **\$10**

'The Trophy Wife' Very Large. This hosta emerges very bright yellow, shining like copper in the springtime sunshine. It will become greener in summer but will grow to become a very tall, upright clump. **\$15**

*'Twice as Nice' Medium to Large. This tetraploid form of 'Ambrosia' is 'Twice as Nice'. Yes, it is a little smaller and more compact but also has more substance and richer wide blue margins and a bright yellow leaf center. The flowers are fragrant, of course. **\$15** 'What's Mine Is Yours' NEW Medium. This is a special hosta for many of us. It is from our late good friend Jack Barta. He shared it with just a few friends labeled simply as "Mine". As it turns out it has leaves that are beautifully cupped but also margins that have gentle waves, a rare combination. It is also one of the darkest blue hostas, looking almost purple in the shade sometimes. Now 'What's Mine Is Yours' **Special \$12**

*'Windy City' Limited! Very Large. Maybe the best of the very large, white-margined round leafed sports from the 'Sum and Substance' line. The light green leaves are larger than dinner plates with a wide white margin. **\$15**

'Appletini' Small. Classic shiny apple green heart shaped leaves make a small flat mound. **\$8**

'Baby Blue Eyes' Small. Dark blue heart shaped leaves make a dense flat mound. **\$8 'Call Me Gorgeous' NEW** Small. Some white-centered hostas do not transition out of tissue culture well at the nursery. They do not make good mature roots and then their leaves melt in summer's heat. But some do. This good-looking tricolored seedling from Doug Beilstein is a root maker. The light-yellow leaf centers become cream with an overlay of light green streaks and darker green margins. Nice purple flowers are produced on straight scapes in summer. **\$15**

*'Crumb Cake' Mini. Round small, shiny rich gold leaves have a unique look. **\$10** 'Dixie's Memory' Limited! Small, this rich emerald, green hosta has wide creamy margins. Each leaf is folded and has a gentle wave to a wide cordate base. There is 'Blue Mouse Ears Supreme' in the background of this one! From Gary Myers, named for his wife. **\$12**

*'Fairy Dust' Limited! Our newest very bright mini that holds that color all season, with good substance, from 'Corkscrew' and 'Green Eyes'. Perfect for the fairy garden. **\$10** 'Ladybug' Limited! Mini. I like minis that look a little different. It is an interesting yellow seedling from 'Vanilla Cream' and Dick Ward that has ruffled leaves and a good growth rate. It is a little too large to be a true mini, but still a perfect fit with the rest of your little ones. **\$10**

*'Lemon Kiss' Limited! Mini The very cute mini has bright yellow round leaves with good substance and intense pink petioles. It makes a very flat mound of tight foliage, a perfect specimen plant. It needs some shade since it stays yellow all summer. **\$12** 'Little Devil' Mini. Green pointed leaves have a narrow bright white margin, making a flat mound. **\$8**

'Little Squirt' Mini. This little hosta grows quickly into a compact clump with long narrow leaves on short petioles. Slightly folded and ruffled green leaves make this clump look like a pin cushion. The white flowers on short scapes are perfectly proportioned. **\$10**

*'Mouse on the Moon' Limited! Mini. First there was 'Solar Mouse' who like Icarus melted in the sun but gave us 'Mouse Madness'. Now we have 'Mouse on the Moon', a fast-growing small hosta with a bright white leaf margin and pointed "ears". It is vigorous like 'Ruffled Mouse Ears' but variegated. **\$12**

'Out of the Fog' Mini. White flecks and streaks on light green pointed leaves that are also folded and slightly wavy. **\$10**

'Ruffle Truffle' Small. This small hosta with uniquely ruffled long narrow leaves is from Matt Bendig. Better yet it emerges light yellow, almost white in spring and becomes blue green in summer. It is certainly different. **\$10**

'Silver Twist' Small. From 'Tortifrons' heritage, these long, lance shaped leaves are blue green with a silver gleam of white wax and a slight twist. **\$10**

'Tiny Gems' Mini. This miniature hosta from Tony Avent is another "gem" in his growing collection of miniature hostas. The heart-shaped blue leaves make a perfectly neat mound. The well-proportioned scapes hold light lavender flowers in summer. **\$8**

'Twinkle Little Star' Mini. A flat mound of wavy very blue foliage that is folded into starshaped points. From Don Dean it makes a dense clump. **\$10**

*'**Twist Tie'** Small. Its spiky twisted blue leaves have very good substance. One of the last hostas to go to sleep in the fall. Very fun. **\$8**

'Wave Motion' Limited! Small. It is a solid green hosta with light and airy long-pointed leaves that wave in the breeze. The leaf margins flow down to the leaf tip that ends in a complete twist. **\$15**

'Yippee' Limited! Mini. Narrow leaves with white margins that are held very upright and shout for glee. Grows well. Cute! **\$10**
